The HELEN FRASER MEMORIAL TROPHY will be awarded for the highest mark obtained in the senior classes of the Speech and Drama Section. In the event off two performers having the highest mark, the one with the highest aggregated mark will be declared the winner. In the event of a tie, the adjudicator's decision is final

The LEONORA EYRE MEMORIAL CUP will be awarded to a highly promising all round performer (though not necessarily a class winner) under 18 years to be chosen by the Adjudicator

The GEORGIA CUP will be awarded to a highly promising performance in one or more of the following classes: solo acting, duologue and mime. The recipient, not necessarily a class winner, will be chosen by the Adjudicator

The WINIFRED COX will be awarded to the performer with the highest marks in the Solo Acting from Shakespeare classes

The MILNER READING SHIELD will be awarded to the performer with the highest mark in the two senior classes of the Prose Reading
